2. Please **drop donations off at 2224 W. Kilbourn Ave.**
3. Please **separate items by category** in bags or boxes. (Ex. Books in one box, food in another)
4. **Furniture and appliance donations must be viewed by City on a Hill staff member prior to drop off.**
5. **All donations must be new or gently used, clean, and work properly.**
6. **City on a Hill does not accept or have the current need for the following items:** Used socks or undergarments, used toys, cassette & VHS tapes, adult & children's clothing, used DVD's, stuffed animals, knit winter wear.
